Fuller Glass Scholarship

J. Fuller Glass established a fund in 1959 in memory of his son, Lt. James Fuller Glass, Jr., for the purpose of helping people as Mr. Glass felt his son would have done had he lived. Mr. Glass directed that the income from the fund be used to help a "worthy boy or girl who is a member of Trinity Church in securing a college education." In the event there are no candidates, the income may be used to help some member of Trinity Church in need of medical care.

Carolyn G. Settle Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established in 1984 by relatives and friends in memory of Carolyn Griffin Settle, a member of Trinity Church. In recognition of her career in nursing, preference is given to students working toward a B.S.N. or graduate nursing degree. If there are no such applicants, then it may be used for any higher education pursuit.

Proctor Scholarship

The scholarship, established in 1993 in memory of John R. and Melissa M. Proctor and their children, was given by William and Sara Proctor. The fund's income is to be used to assist Trinity Church members in obtaining a baccalaureate degree from a four-year college or university. Preference is to be given to Trinity Church members who live near Trinity Church's buildings' site.

General Scholarship Fund

This fund was established by the Rogers family in memory of Maude Rogers and Ralph Rogers and may be used by Trinity Church members in pursuing extended education.

Awards

The awards are made by a Scholarship Committee composed of the Pastor, the Chair of the Higher Education Committee, and the Chair of the Board of Trustees of Trinity Church. Awards are made for one year. Announcements of the awards are to be made about July 1 each year.

Amount

The amount of the scholarship shall be determined each year by the Scholarship Committee. Payment is made to the bursar of the institution attended.

Application

- 1. The application shall be accompanied by a transcript of the student's scholarship records.
- 2. The applicant shall submit a brief statement of the vocational goals which are being pursued through a college education.
- 3. Applicants shall secure reference from one teacher stating known qualities such as sincerity, dependability, and leadership that the applicant may possess which will enable him or her to take advantage of a college education. A reference from a church member or official indicating the level of commitment to Christ and his Church shall be obtained. These references, along with the application form, should be sent to the Pastor for consideration by the Scholarship Committee.

Revocation

Should the recipient fail to maintain a satisfactory academic record or withdraw from college, the amount received may be considered a payable loan at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
